Martyrs Marcian and Martyrius, the Notaries of Constantinople

Note: On this day the Church commemorates St. Martyrius the Deacon (XIVth cent.), whose relics lie in the Far Caves of the Kiev-Caves Lavra; we have a portion of his relics in our church.

Sun. Dec. 26 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **27th Sunday after Pentecost:**
Sunday of the Holy Forefathers; Martyrs Eustratius, Auxentius,
Mardarius, Eugene, and Orestes at Sebaste.
