Sat. Sept. 5 5 pm All-night Vigil.
Sun. Sept. 6 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **13th Sunday after Pentecost:**
Hieromartyr Eutychus, disciple of St. John the Theologian.

(ATTENTION: From this day on, Sunday Liturgies will begin at 9:30 am.)

After the Liturgy there will be a Moleben for the beginning of the school year.

Mon. Sept. 7 6:30 pm Vespers and Matins.
Tue. Sept. 8 9 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos;**
Martyrs Adrian and Natalia.

On this date we venerate our Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos that has miraculously renewed itself.

*Note: On **Friday, September 11** the Church commemorates the Beheading of St. John the Baptist. This is a fast day – wine and oil are allowed, but not meat, dairy products, or fish.*
