All dates according to the civil calendar.

Sat. Sept. 4 5 pm All-night Vigil.
Sun. Sept. 5 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **11th Sunday after Pentecost:**
Apodosis of Dormition.

After the Liturgy there will be a Moleben for the beginning of the school year.

Tue. Sept. 7 6 pm Vespers and Matins.
Wed. Sept. 8 9 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos;**
Martyrs Adrian and Natalia.

On this date we venerate our Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos that has miraculously renewed itself.

*Note: On **Saturday, September 11** the Church commemorates the Beheading of St. John the Baptist. This is a fast day – wine and oil are allowed, but not meat, dairy products, or fish.*

Sat. Sept. 11 5 pm All-night Vigil.
Sun. Sept. 12 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **12th Sunday after Pentecost:**
Repose of St. Alexander, abbot of Svir;
the Translation of the Relics of St. Alexander Nevsky.

Today is Fr. Alexander's Saint's Day.

Sun. Oct. 3 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **15th Sunday after Pentecost:**
Afterfeast of the Exaltation of the Cross;
Great-martyr Eustathios Placidas, his wife Theopiste, and their sons.

Note: On this day the Church commemorates St. Theophan the Faster (XIIth cent.), whose relics lie in the Near Caves of the Kiev-Caves Lavra; we have a portion of his relics in our church.
