Martyr Vassa and her children.

(ATTENTION: From this day on, Sunday Liturgies will begin at 9:30 am.)

After the Liturgy there will be a Moleben for the beginning of the school year.

Thur. Sept. 7 7 pm Vespers and Matins.
Fri. Sept. 8 8 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos;**
Martyrs Adrian and Natalia.

On this date we venerate our Vladimir Icon of the Theotokos that has miraculously renewed itself.

Sat. Sept. 9 6 pm All-night Vigil.
Sun. Sept. 10 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **14th Sunday after Pentecost:**
The Synaxis of the Fathers of the Kiev Caves who repose in
the Far Caves.

*Note: On **Monday, September 11** the Church commemorates the Beheading of St. John the Baptist. This is a fast day – wine and oil are allowed, but not meat, dairy products, or fish.*

Sun. Sept. 17 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **15th Sunday after Pentecost: Hieromartyr Babylas, Bishop of Antioch, and those with him; Prophet Moses.**

Wed. Sept. 20	7 pm	All-night Vigil with Litia and Blessing of the Loaves.
Thur. Sept. 21	8 am	Hours and Divine Liturgy. <u>NATIVITY OF THE MOST HOLY THEOTOKOS.</u>

Sat. Sept. 23 6 pm All-night Vigil.
Sun. Sept. 24 9:30 am Hours and Divine Liturgy. **16th Sunday after Pentecost: Afterfeast of the Nativity of the Theotokos; Venerable Theodora of Alexandria.**

Tue. Sept. 26	7 pm	All-night Vigil with Litia, Blessing of the Loaves and bringing out of the Cross.
Wed. Sept. 27	8 am	Hours and Divine Liturgy. <u>EXALTATION OF THE CROSS OF THE LORD.</u>

Fast day – wine and oil permitted, but not meat, dairy products, or fish.
